NOTICE

Guidelines for DUSU/College Students' Union Elections 2026-2027

All candidates contesting the DUSU/College Students' Union Elections 2026-2027, along with their supporters, are hereby directed to strictly comply with the University of Delhi Code of Conduct and the following guidelines:

- 1. Campaigning/Canvassing Hours:** Campaigning and canvassing shall be permitted only between 08:30 A.M. and 02:30 P.M.
- 2. Number of Campaigners:** Each candidate may be accompanied by not more than five (05) bona fide students for campaigning within the College premises.
- 3. Campaign Material:** There shall be a complete prohibition on printed campaign material, including printed posters, pamphlets, banners, flex posters and billboards. Only handmade posters/material shall be permitted, and that too at designated places notified by the College/Wall of Democracy. Block printing, spray painting and any other form of permanent marking are strictly prohibited.
- 4. Protection of College Property:** No candidate or supporter shall deface, damage or misuse any College property, including walls, buildings, furniture, website or official social-media platforms. Candidates shall be jointly and severally responsible for any such acts committed by their supporters.
- 5. Prohibited Campaigning Methods:** The use of loudspeakers, vehicles, animals, mascots, characters, costumes or any other means likely to cause disturbance for campaigning is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Gifts and Promotional Items:** Distribution of gifts, souvenirs or any other articles bearing or promoting the name, photograph or identity of a candidate is strictly prohibited. Canopies, umbrellas or similar structures displaying candidates' names or campaign material shall not be installed within the College premises.
- 7. Vehicles and Traffic Regulations:** Unauthorized vehicles parked within the campus shall be challaned and/or towed away in accordance with the applicable Traffic Police protocol.
- 8. Public Meetings:** Prior intimation to the Election Committee is mandatory for organising any public meeting, gathering or election-related programme within the College premises. This is necessary to avoid disruption, traffic congestion and clashes between programmes of different student groups/candidates.





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9. Entry into the College: Entry of students for election-related activities shall be permitted only through main Gate and upon production of a valid College ID card/fee receipt along with a valid photo ID, as applicable.

10. Prohibition of Unfair Practices: Bribery, intimidation, impersonation of voters, coercion, inducement and all other forms of corrupt or unfair electoral practices are strictly prohibited.

11. Maintenance of Peace and Communal Harmony: No candidate or supporter shall undertake or encourage any activity that promotes mutual hatred, tension or differences among students on the basis of caste, community, religion, language or any other ground.

12. Social Media Campaigning: Candidates may use social media and other paperless means for canvassing, subject to strict compliance with the University of Delhi guidelines and applicable rules.

13. Responsibility of Candidates: Every candidate shall ensure that their supporters, campaigners and representatives strictly adhere to these guidelines and the University of Delhi Code of Conduct.

14. Consequences of Violation: Any violation of the above guidelines or the University of Delhi Code of Conduct may result in cancellation of the nomination/candidature or, where applicable, cancellation of the elected post, apart from disciplinary action by the competent authorities.

All candidates and students are hereby directed to conduct all election-related activities in a peaceful, disciplined, orderly and lawful manner and to ensure strict compliance with the University of Delhi Code of Conduct.

Any violation of the above-mentioned conditions shall invite strict action, including cancellation of the nomination/candidature of the concerned candidate, as deemed appropriate by the competent authority.
